Worship:

Think about who God is and what He means to you. Have you experienced something new about God recently. Use the worship time to lift God up with words of praise and thanks.

Word:

Although much of the talk was based on Acts 3 & 4 the Lifegroup notes expand on Exodus 4 and the question 'What is in our hands?' Familiarise yourself with where this encounter between God and Moses happens in the Bible. Read Exodus 4 verses 1 to 17 and discuss the following questions:

- 1) What do we learn about God and Moses in this encounter?
- 2) This conversation between God and Moses is recorded in the Bible, but how do you sense God speaking to you?
- 3) Do you ever feel anxious like Moses about where you are at in your faith and what you sense God is saying? (This might be an opportunity to pray for people)
- 4) Has God ever given you any signs that have convinced you to act on something? What were they and what did you do?
- 5) Are you doing everything that you feel God is asking of you? Or is there something else in your hand that God is speaking to you about?

Works:

Think about your Lifegroup in the coming autumn season... Are there any new people that you are getting to know? Could they be invited to Lifegroup? Are there people you could commit to pray for?
