Worship

Use Psalm 136 as a responsive worship activity.
Whoever is leading reads the first line and everyone together responds with... 'His love endures forever.' After the Psalm spend some time praying out prayers of thanks to God.

Word

What do you think of when you think of a bold person?
Positives and negatives!
Look at the 4 characteristics of a bolder life we see in Moses and unpack them.

Going Read Matthew 28:19-20

If going doesn't have to mean leaving where you are, what does it mean?

What have you learned or experienced about stepping out of comfort zones and crossing dividing lines?

Serving Read Matthew 20:25-28

What is it in Jesus' life of servant hood that inspires you?
Why is serving so powerful and yet so difficult?

Speaking Read Ephesians 4:15-16

Why is the tongue such a powerful thing?
How can we be bolder in the way we speak that brings life to others?

Giving Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-8

Why is giving so linked to the bigger, braver, bolder life?

Works

Consider Leon's final challenge from Sunday.
'What can you do today?'
Encourage everyone to share one thing they want to do today that will help lead towards a bigger, braver and bolder life.

Finish by praying for each other and pray for those you know who don't know God yet.
