Welcome - Ask each person to share one good thing that happened to them since you last met.

Worship - Open the evening by inviting people to pray, ask for an awareness of God's presence. Take your time, play some music, read a Psalm, invite God to be present.....

Word - Tonight's theme is 'Greater than our doubts'

Read John 20 v. 24-31

- What strikes you from this story?
- What impresses you about Thomas? What about Jesus?
- Why do you think doubt gets a "bad press" at times?
- If doubt is not the same as unbelief, why are we afraid at times to voice our doubts?
- What are some of the most common doubts people have?
- When have you doubted? What did you learn or experience?
- How can doubt strengthen our faith?
- What are the dangers if we don't deal with our doubts well?
- If we have doubts, what are some of the things we should do?

Going deeper - read the following verses and discuss what they teach us about doubt
James 1 v.5-8 / Matt. 11 v.1-6

Works - Look at the following verses that teach us how to relate to others who doubt.

Rom. 15 v.1/ Jude 22

Finish by praying for anyone you know who may be having some doubts right now, in the group or outside of the group.
