Lifegroup Notes

Welcome – What is one of the best things that has ever happened to you in a Lifegroup?

Word – This week we're looking at the life of a group and we're starting with Jesus and his small group, namely, the twelve disciples. Explain that when Jesus called the twelve they would have spent a lot of time together over the next three years. Try, if you can, to use what you know of the Bible combined with your imagination to enter into it and discuss the following ...

- What words would you use to describe being in Jesus' small group?
- What things do you think they would have done together?
- What conversations do you think Jesus and his disciples had?
- How close are we in our groups and friendships to that?
- How could the things we do and the conversations we have change to be closer to Jesus' small group?

Read Acts chapter 2, verses 42 to 47 and discuss the following ...

- What would a group like this look like now?
- How do the different things that the followers did then relate to what we do now?
- What are the challenges involved in being more like Jesus' small group and the group in Acts chapter 2?
- What one thing are you taking from your group's discussion that you can put into practice?

Worship – Read Psalm 103 and then pray and take communion together.

Works – Tickets for the Christmas event go on sale this coming Sunday 3rd November. Think and pray about people who you could possibly invite.
