Welcome – The boxer Muhammad Ali once said “I am the greatest”. He obviously had a very strong view of himself. In your eyes which person is/was the greatest (other than Jesus) and why?

Word & works - Read Matthew 11:7-11 and explain how Jesus points to John the Baptist as being great, then discuss the following ...

- What makes people great?
- What did John the Baptist do?
- Why did Jesus say that John the Baptist was great?
- Why does the second half of verse 11 give us hope that we can be great too? What must we do?
- For us to become greater we must be ready to point to Jesus. Read John 3:30. How can this verse inspire us to point towards Jesus?
- How can we become less and Jesus become greater in our everyday? Practically what does that mean for you? Name one or two things you want to do this week to make Jesus greater in your week.

Pray for the things people have named. Pray for the courage and surrender that is needed for these things to happen in our lives. Be ready to lay things at the feet of Jesus so that he can become greater and we can become less.

Worship – Spend this time thinking on all the characteristics of Jesus (Redeemer, forgiver, compassionate and so on). Speak these out and write them down. Pray over these characteristics of Jesus and give thanks for who He is.
