Worship

It is thought that David wrote Psalm 24 to celebrate the moving of the Ark of the Covenant from Obed-edom's house to Jerusalem. Read, meditate and declare the words out of Psalm 24. Give God thanks that He is invincible in battle and that He is the King of glory!

Word and Prayer

- Why is Obed-edom so 'out of the ordinary'? Recap the story.
- What can we learn about the life that Obed-edom lived?
- How can this impact us today, as we live out our faith?
- What are some of the hindrances that we have to move or put aside so that we focus on God's presence?
- Discuss the 3 p's (Put up / Pull out / Push in) that Simon mentioned on Sunday. Have you found these to be effective or a challenge in your life? What have you learnt through these experiences?
- What was the legacy that Obed-edom left behind?

Finish by praying for one another in the group. Pray that they would have the same spirit that Obed-edom had and that they would desire God and put Him first in everything. Pray the legacy they leave behind would be greater than that of Obed-edom.
