Prayer

Each week we are having a prayer focus as part this “breaking through” season

- **Prayer Topic** ... 35th Celebrations
- **Key verse** ... Psalm 9 v. 1-2
“I will give thanks to you, Lord, with all my heart; I will tell of your wonderful deeds. I will be glad and rejoice in you; I will sing the praises of your name, O Most High.”
- **Supporting information** ... Landmarks and celebrations are always important for the people of God. Throughout the Old Testament, various individuals and groups are leaving landmarks and memorials all over the place to remind them of what God has done, such as Joseph in Genesis 28 when he creates a pillar of stones at Bethel to remind him that God met him there. Zion’s 35th celebration is a time to honour the past and to envision a bigger future.
- **Prayer activity** ... Invite people to pray for ...
 - 1) A release of faith-filled joyful celebration to follow the giving
 - 2) An increased heart for serving
 - 3) A bigger heart for our community
 - 4) An increase of God’s favour on us with ‘both God and man’ (Luke 2:52)
 - 5) In summary: BREAKTHROUGH – to another level of seeing His kingdom come!
- **Debrief** ... After praying invite people to share anything the Holy Spirit impressed upon them.
