

Sunday 7th December – Lifegroup notes – ‘Beyond the old’

Welcome

It's nearly Christmas when people get lots of new things. What's one old thing you wish was still around? Maybe a TV show, a game, a toy, a gadget, clothing etc.?

Works

Tonight's theme is 'Beyond the old' looking at old and new. Begin by praying for the church over the next few weeks with all the opportunities for people to hear an old message but in new ways. Pray for the Christmas production and other events taking place.

Word

Read Mark 2 v.21-22 ...

- What does this image of new wine and old wineskins say to you about human beings?
- What does it say to you about God and His intentions?
- In what ways can we become old wineskins? Give examples ...
- Why can change be so difficult?
- Why can change be so rewarding?

Read Romans 6 v.1-14 ...

- What does it actually say?
- What does it mean?
- How can we apply it to our lives?

Spend some time sharing what 'new' you want to see in your life next year. In what ways might you need to go 'Beyond the old' in order to receive the new God wants to pour in?

Worship

Finish by sharing communion with each other. Read Romans 6 v.1-4 again.
