Re-read **2 Kings 5: 1-15**

1. **Awakening** for Naaman came through other people speaking into his life.
 - How have we been used by God to speak into other's lives?
 - How have we been like Naaman's servants – willing to speak up in intimidating situations?

2. **Brutal honesty** came through other people turning on the light bulbs Naaman had missed through his pride and control.
 - How would you define the word PRIDE?
 - What makes pride so difficult to see in our own lives?
 - Do we have any control issues?
 - Do any of these statements resonate with you?
 - *You find yourself angry, anxious or frustrated when what you want to happen doesn't happen.
 - *You get frustrated with yourself when you mess up.
 - *You struggle to acknowledge that there are things outside of your control
 - *You can tend to blame others when things don't go your way.
 - *You have a short temper which can be ignited when you cannot get someone to do what you want them to do, in the way you want them to do it.

3. **Immediate action** came when Naaman got down off his high horse and waded into the river, obeying what Elisha had asked him to do.

Ability + Opportunity = Responsibility

What reasons do we have for not obeying God? Is it our pride, logic, anger, past or fear etc?

Read **1 Corinthians 1:25**.

- Have we ever been surprised by who has spoken into our lives?
- Have we given people permission to tell us the last ten per cent we need to hear?
- Do we have those people in our lives?
