Read Matthew 28 v.16-20

Set the scene for people by recapping what was shared Sunday in terms of background to this story.

- Look at v.17. Why is this such a powerful verse?
- In what ways can we hesitate when it comes to our faith and trust in God?
- Why is it so important to keep 'showing up' even with our hesitation or doubt?
- Look at v.18. What does it mean to you that Jesus has 'all authority'?
- Can you find some other Bible verses that speak of the authority Jesus has?
- What does it mean in our lives to let Jesus have 'all authority'?
- Look at v.19 and 20. Unpack the 3 things Jesus commands us to do.
- This is so familiar to us but how do we react to this command of Jesus?
- What does it mean for you to 'go'?
- What can this look like in everyday life?
- Think about this phrase 'everyone, everywhere, everyday'. Why is this so potentially powerful and impactful?
- Read Acts 1 v. 8. Where are you challenged to go these days, is it your Jerusalem, your Judea, your Samaria or the ends of the earth?
- Look at v.20. What does it mean to you that Jesus not only commands but He also promises that He will be with us wherever we go?

Finish by praying for each other and encouraging each other to 'go'

Pray for people you know, who don't know Jesus. How can you 'walk across the room' and go to them?

Who needs prayer for the presence of the Holy Spirit right now in their life?
