

Welcome - Use the phrase 'what did you see?' to share your highlights from the opening weekend.

Spend some time as a group in prayer.

Read Psalm 9 v.1

"I will praise you, Lord, with all my heart; I will tell of all the marvellous things you have done."

Give God thanks for all He has done - use a large piece of paper to write down what you're grateful to God for, as individuals and for us as a church

Read Jeremiah 30 v.19

"From them will come songs of thanksgiving and the sound of rejoicing. I will add to their numbers, and they will not be decreased; I will bring them honour, and they will not be disdained."

Ask God for a move of His spirit among us as a church, that we will grow in desire and devotion and that He will add to us those being saved!

Pray for the leadership after the work for the opening weekend

Pray for the youth and children's work

Pray for the life groups and other ministries within the church.

Word - Using the phrase 'What do you see?' open up a conversation about what God could do if we really took him at his word and entered in to all He had for us.

Use the Psalm Leon read out on Sunday...

*"When the Lord brought back his exiles to Jerusalem, it was like a dream! We were filled with laughter, and we sang for joy. And the other nations said, "What amazing things the Lord has done for them." Yes, the Lord has done amazing things for us! What joy! Restore our fortunes, Lord, as streams renew the desert. Those who plant in tears will harvest with shouts of joy. They weep as they go to plant their seed, but they sing as they return with the harvest." -
Psalms 126:1-6 NLT*

- What strikes you from these words?
- What have been your experiences personally that resonate with these words?
- Where can you see the journey of our church in these words?

Finish by praying again, asking God to do more than we can ask or imagine!
