Great Expectations – Week 3

Sunday 8th October

Welcome - What's your fear or even phobia?

Word - This week we are looking at how to defeat our giants, so we can step into the future God has for us.

The classic story is David & Goliath.

Find a way to read the story out, maybe a verse each - 1 Samuel 17.

- What do you love about this story?
- What impacts you and challenges you the most?
- We all have giants in our lives, what are examples of the kind of giants we can have?

Leon suggested there were 3 twists in this story....look at each and discuss them...

Twist number 1 - "David is not us, David is Jesus!"

- What are the implications of this?
- Discuss this quote, "the antidote to fear is faith and the soundtrack is worship" - Louie Giglio

Twist number 2 - "Your giant is dead but still deadly"

- What does this mean?
- Read Hebrews 2 v.14-15 - What does this mean for us?

Twist number 3 - "David's motivation was the glory of God"

- Often we see giant killing as only about our own freedom but how would it change our perspective if we saw it all for the glory of God?

Spend some time praying for each other; are there giants you are currently facing in your life?

Invite the presence of Jesus, He is the giant killer!!

Finish by praying for the church, for protection over the leaders, for the moving of the Holy Spirit and that we as a church will live for the glory of His name!
