Word - Ask someone to read the famous passage Ecc. 3 v. 1-8
Spend a few minutes reflecting silently on the words
Then invite the group to pray as they feel inspired from the words they’ve just heard.

On Sunday Leon shared some highlights of his recent trip around 3 thoughts...

1. There’s a time to go for it!

Read Josh. 18 v.3

- What have been your experiences around waiting on God when at times He has been waiting on you?
- What stops us entering in to what God has for us?
- How can we help each other press in to what God wants for us?

2. There’s a time to cross a bridge

The issue of difference and diversity is a big issue in our world right now

- In what ways should we as the church take a prophetic lead in this?
- How can we practically cross bridges to build genuine relationship and embrace difference and diversity?

3. There’s a time to dig a little deeper

Read 2 Kings 3 v.16-17

- Why is this image of digging ditches important in understanding how God wants to move among us?
- In what areas of our life can we dig a little deeper and what’s the benefit?

Finish by praying for our church. Pray for the 3 locations by name. Pray for the 3 communities by name. Pray for each other for the season of life we find ourselves in.
